JAMES ANDRIOLE, DO RECEIVES FOMA DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

Tallahassee, FL – James Andriole, DO of Tallahassee, Florida, received the 2017 Distinguished Service Award from the Florida Osteopathic Medical Association (FOMA) during its 2017 Annual Convention held February 22-26, 2017, in Weston, Florida. A crowd of more than 900 osteopathic physicians, healthcare professionals, and students attended the Convention.

Since 1960, the FOMA Distinguished Service Award has been presented to an individual in recognition of outstanding accomplishments in scientific, professional, osteopathic education, or service to the osteopathic profession or citizens of Florida at a state or national level. It is the highest honor that the FOMA can bestow upon an individual.

Dr. Andriole is a graduate of the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine. He was appointed to the Florida Board of Osteopathic Medicine in 2000, and continues to serve that body as a member of its Probable Cause Panel. He is a past president of the American Association of Osteopathic Examiners (AAOE), has served the Federation of State Medical Boards, and is President/CEO of Disability Consultants USA, Inc.

He currently serves as the Chair of the National Board of Osteopathic Medical Examiners State Medical Board Task Force and is a member of the Test Accommodation Committee, the Finance Committee, and the COMVEX Subcommittee. Dr. Andriole was honored with the Archie Feinstein, DO Lifetime Achievement Award by the American Association of Osteopathic Examiners last month.

The Florida Osteopathic Medical Association (FOMA) is the state association for osteopathic physicians in Florida and has been serving osteopathic physicians since 1904.
